Only in one place, the Easy MarkDown Editor, 3rd party extensions is used for editing description text. This is subject of ATAG and was not reviewed in depth by *Axway* – the component was only tested on fundamental level for labeling and keyboard navigation, where ATAG refers to WCAG, and it was concluded: it fails to meet the required standards and guidelines. When validating the output of the editor, it was concluded: the content is close to meet WCAG, with the only exception alt text for images is only available in preview mode. The findings are noted in the remarks and explanation column. No official accessibility statemen was found to be yet provided from the authors of the product to be attached as a reference to this report.

		In addition, the content produced as a result from using the editor does not provide alternative text for image – there is a way to insert alt text, the same is displayed in preview mode, but the result is not published correctly.
